VICTORY SHIELD COMPETITION RULES

- 1 The trophy to be held by the winners for the Season ensuing and handed back to the Association on demand.
- 2 Entry into the Competition must be from Affiliated Clubs and must be a Club entry.
- 3 Each entry is to be represented by two fours, one four to play at Home and one four to play on the opponents green. Both fours to play on the same day. The games shall consist of 21 Ends. In Finalists Section Games and Finals, both fours play Tie ends should the result be a draw at the completion of 21 Ends.
- 4 A Player can play for one entry only during the season.
- 5 Any Club Not fulfilling their Fixtures in the First year would be allowed to play in the following year, but failure in the Second year would mean Disqualification in the Third year.
- 6 The Competition shall in the first stage be played in sections and on a league basis. 1 point to be awarded for a home win, 1 point to be awarded for an away win. 1 point to be awarded for an overall win, making 3 points to be awarded in each match. In the event of a draw, 1/2 to be awarded for a home draw, 1/2 point to be awarded for an away draw and for an overall draw
- 7 In the event of a points Tie at the end of the League programme, the Section Winners shall be determined by Shots Average.
- 8 Section Winners shall compete on neutral Greens and on dates arranged by the Association a Knockout basis, thus forming the semi-final and final rounds of the Competition
- 9 The Victory Shield Competition draw shall be made by the President of the Association or his Deputy at the first Council Meeting in each Association year.
- 10 A second draw of Section Finalist shall be made by the President of the Association or his Deputy
- 11 The Victory Shield Competition Secretary must be informed on the appropriate result cards of the result of all matches immediately by both Clubs competing
- 12 Any dispute, which may arise, must be referred to the Victory Shield Competition Secretary, the Victory Shield Secretary must report to the President and Hon.General Secretary. Disputes will be adjudicated by the Officers of the Association.
